

CHEMICAL SAFETY GUIDELINES



FOR YOUR SAFETY

- Before you work with chemicals, read container labels and Safety Data Sheets.
 - 2. Wear Personal Protective Equipment that fits.
 - 3. Never sniff a chemical to find out what or where it is.
 - 4. Add acids to water, not the other way around.
 - 5. Mix corrosives or solvents slowly.
 - 6. Know the location of eyewash stations and safety showers.
 - After you work with chemicals, don't eat or smoke until you wash your hands well.
