

Preventing and Dealing with Frozen Pipes



Preventing Frozen Pipes

Seal Cracks and Holes: Keep cold air out by sealing gaps around pipes. Insulate Pipes: Use insulation or heat tape.

Maintain Heat: Keep building temperature at least 55F.

Allow Faucets to Drip: Prevent freezing by letting faucets drip during extreme cold.

Open Cabinet Doors: Let warm air reach pipes under sinks. **Disconnect Outside Hoses:** Prevent bursts by disconnecting hoses.

Dealing with Frozen Pipes

Shut Off Main Water Supply: Prevent bursts by shutting off the main supply.
Apply Heat: Thaw pipes gently with a hair dryer, heating pad, or warm towels.
Avoid Open Flames: Never use open flames to thaw pipes.
Check for Leaks: Inspect for leaks after thawing and call a plumber if needed.
Turn Water Back On: Slowly restore water and monitor for issues.
