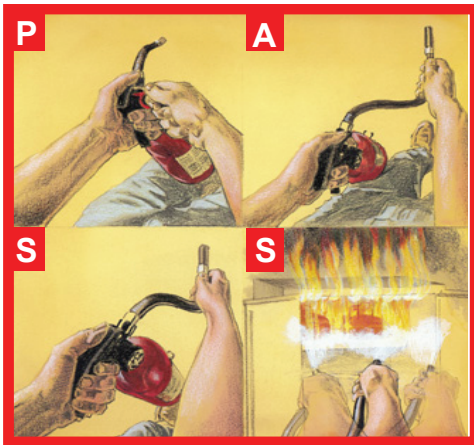

RISK REMINDER

Fire Extinguishers

The faceplate of every fire extinguisher shows the class or classes of fire it is designed to fight.

To properly use a fire extinguisher, follow the P-A-S-S procedure:

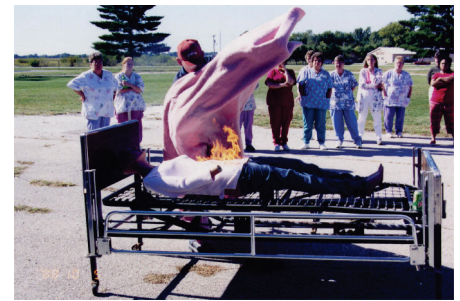


- P** Pull the Pin.
- A** Aim the extinguisher's hose or nozzle at the bottom of the fire.
- S** Squeeze the trigger
- S** Sweep it slowly back and forth, covering the entire fire with the extinguishing substance.

What to Do if a Fire Occurs

Prepare yourself in advance! Take a moment to review your Employer's written Emergency Action Plan. It should include:

- How to notify the Fire Department
- Designated employees in charge of evacuation
- Detailed evacuation plans
