

OSHA has several safety standards for mezzanines, including:

Guardrails- The top edge of a guardrail must be 42 inches above the floor. Mid-rails should be positioned halfway along the railing's edge and surface. Additionally, guardrail posts should not be spaced more than eight feet apart.

Toe-boards- Toe-boards must be at least 3.5 inches high.

- Safety Gates- Gates should be equipped with safety latches to prevent accidental opening when the load area is active. Alternatively, a tightly secure chain can be used.
- **Stairs-** Standard stairs with uniform riser heights and tread depths are recommended. Spiral, ship or alternating tread-type stairs can be used only when it is not feasible to provide standard stairs. They must be installed, used and maintained according to the manufacturer's instructions

Weight Limit - A Weight Limit must be posted on the mezzanine.
