## Playground Equipment









Here are a few important items to inspect when examining your playground equipment. Remember, all annual and regular maintenance inspections should be documented.:

**Safety Surfacing** - Surfacing such as wood chips, mulch, sand, pea gravel, or shredded rubber tires must have at least 9 inches thickness under and around equipment. Surfacing should be free of trash, glass, metal, and animal waste.

**Swings -** The chains and swing seats/buckets need to be in good condition. Verify S-hooks are closed.

**Mechanical and Structural Breakdowns -** No broken or missing components on the equipment including handrails, guardrails, protective barriers, steps or rungs. Inspect for loose, worn out, or missing bolts and fasteners.

**Age Specific Equipment with Signage -** Playground equipment should display age appropriate signage. Categories include; toddlers 6 months to 2 years, Preschoolers 2-5 years, and school aged children 5-12 years.

**Entanglement or Entrapment Hazards -** Bolts should not protrude from the equipment. Openings in guardrails, between ladder rungs and other openings must measure less than 3.5 inches or more than 9 inches.

All Equipment Should be Anchored.
