

Park Inspections



Conducting park inspections is crucial for identifying and addressing potential hazards to ensure public safety. Focus on key areas to prevent accidents and create a safer environment for visitors.

- Electrical boxes/panels should not contain exposed wires and open fuses. Doors/covers should be locked.
- No sharp points or jagged edges on barriers, guardrails, benches, etc.
- Wood benches are not splintered or broken.
- Verify area is free of trash and debris and that trash dumpsters and receptacles are available for trash collection.
- Ensure proper signage is in place and verify that lighting (if applicable) is adequate and functioning.
- Buildings and restrooms have locks and not open 24 hours.
- Fix tripping hazards, holes, exposed tree roots, raised sidewalks.
- Trails and/or paths are clearly marked and free of hazards.
